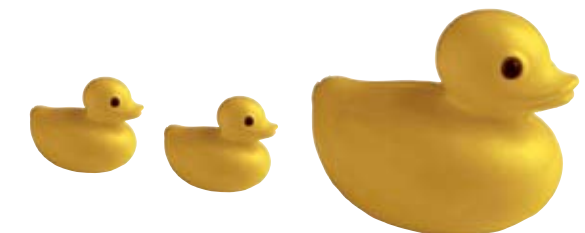

Our Level II Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) offers the most sophisticated care for our tiniest of patients.


Our maternity suites are beautifully furnished and decorated for a “homelike” feel. Soft colors, wood floors and coordinating bedding offer a comfortable, yet highly functional and nurturing room for your stay.


Private Birth Suites—


The Labor-Delivery-Recovery (LDR) suites allow you to remain in one room during all phases of your labor and delivery. Specialized birthing beds convert to an upright position to allow the forces of gravity to help mom with an easier delivery. Your room has a private bathroom with a shower and is fully equipped with everything you may need for delivery, including an advanced monitoring system that allows you the freedom to walk around during labor.

 **Surgical Suites** – Fully-equipped for cesarean sections, this suite is located very close to our LDR suites.

 **Couplet Care** – Our suites are designed to give you special time with your baby who will remain with you during your stay.

 **Perinatology Program** – Care for complicated high-risk pregnancies.

 **Infant Security** – A comprehensive security system ensures the safety of your baby.

 **Education** – Our Mother-Baby trained nurses offer round-the-clock breastfeeding support so that all moms feel secure before leaving the hospital. Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU) – Specially trained staff provide an extra measure of critical care.

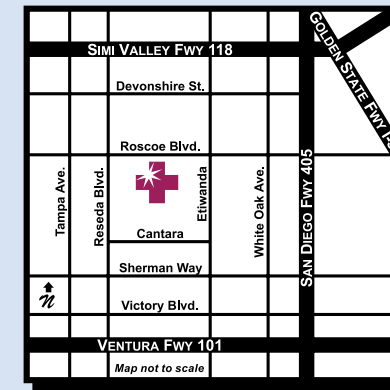
